Responsibility, Emotions, Academic Success, careers, Character Education, and Healthy Choices
Once every day six day rotation, 25 minutes.

promotes success in school beyond reading and math by helping children know how to learn and how to get along with others.

Skills for Learning: focus their attention, listen carefully, use self-talk to stay on task, and be assertive when asking for help with school work.

Empathy: Students learn to identify and understand their own and others' feelings. Students also learn how to take another's perspective and how to show compassion.

Emotion Management: Students learn specific skills for calming down when experiencing strong feelings such as anxiety or anger.

Problem Solving: Students learn a process for problem solving with others in a positive way.

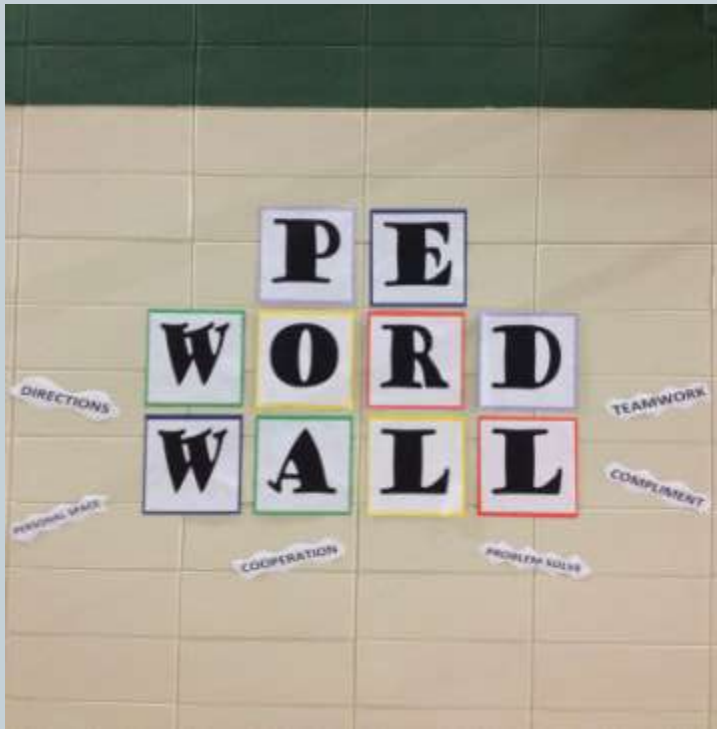
